ZETA AMICAE HISTORY

As early as 1940, graduate chapters of Zeta Phi Beta began to realize the importance of the prestige, good will and cooperation of women who, for various reasons, were not members of any Greek-letter organization. Under the administration of Soror/Friend Lullelia Harrison, the first Amicae auxiliary was chartered in Houston, Texas in 1948, making Zeta the first sorority in the National Pan- Hellenic Council to organize an auxiliary group.
