- 5. Essays are judged on content and grammar style. Proofread and spell check for accuracy.
- 6. Give yourself enough time to request all of the necessary materials especially letters of recommendation. They play an important role and should be informative and speak to your qualifications and character. Brief and uninformative recommendations do not weigh well in the judging process.
- 7. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Zeta Amicae Auxiliary of Alsip Illinois, reserves the right to use the scholarship recipient's name, photo and information for the Sorority's and/or auxiliaries publicity and advertising of this scholarship.

Along with the application, please submit the following:

- 1. An official transcript from the college/university directly to the Scholarship Committee
- 2. Two letters of recommendation from:
 - a. A Professor, Guidance Counselor, Minister or Community Leader who can attest to your community service, leadership or academic standing
 - b. Your Amicae Auxiliary Sponsor or an elected officer of the Sponsoring Chapter
- 3. A brief bio and current headshot, emailed to alsipamice@gmail.com in case selected
